

ITINERARY:

D1: SEP 09 (WED) CEBU - VIENNA

Depart Cebu for Vienna (via Taipei)

D2: SEP 10 (THU) VIENNA-CESKYKRUMLOV-PRAGUE (Austria/Czech)

Welcome to Vienna! On arrival, after immigrations and customs formalities, you will embark on your European journey visiting the South city of the bohemian region “**Cesky Krumlov**”. It’s bisected by the Vltava River and dominated by its 13th-Century castle. The Castle has Gothic, Renaissance and baroque elements. There are panoramic views of the old town and the river from the top of its round bell tower. After the tour, proceed to Prague for check-in, dinner and overnight. (B/D)

D3: SEP 11 (FRI) PRAGUE (Czech Republic)

Welcome to Prague! The capital and largest city of the Czech Republic is touted as one if not the most beautiful city of Europe. First stop is a visit to a UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE site - The **Church of the Lady of Victorious**. This church houses the image of **Sto. Niño de Praga**. Pope Leo XIII approved the devotion to the image in 1896 and instituted a sodality in its favour. On 30 March 1913, Pope Pius X further organised the Confraternity of the Infant Jesus of Prague, while Pope Pius XI granted its first canonical coronation in 1924. Pope Benedict XVI crowned the image for the second time during his Apostolic visit to the Czech Republic on 26 September 2009. Continue the tour to the **Old Royal Palace, Prague Castle, the St. Georges Basilica**, Also, visit **St. Vitus Cathedral**, the Seat of the Archbishop of Prague and the most important church in the country. Afterwards, visit the **Golden Lane and Daliborka Tower**. See **Charles Bridge** and walk along the **Astronomical Clock**, situated at Old Town Hall where you can shop for some Bohemian crystals. (B/D)

D4: SEP 12 (SAT) PRAGUE - KRAKOW (Poland)

After breakfast, we head off to Krakow, Poland the birth place of Pope John Paul II. Enjoy the long drive today past hills and mountains with stops on the way. Dinner and check-in at hotel. (B/D)

D5: SEP 13 (SUN) KRAKOW (Poland)

Krakow is a treasure trove of Gothic & Renaissance art and architecture. A full day sightseeing tour includes the city’s most notable landmarks: **St. Mary’s Basilica**, famous for its wooden altar, the largest Gothic art piece in the world; **Wawel Castle & Cathedral**;

the medieval **Old Town**; the 14th-century buildings of the **Jagiellonian University**, where the young Karol Józef Wojtyła studied theology. End the day with a visit to **Wieliczka Saltmine & Museum**, here we discover an underground world made of salt, with rich interior decorations of the chapels, the original linings of the galleries & workings, & the underground salt lakes. Dinner at a local restaurant. Check in hotel & overnight. (B/D)

D6: SEP 14 (MON) KRAKOW - WADOWICE - BUDAPEST (Hungary)

We head on to Budapest today. First stop is at the birthplace of Pope John Paul II in Wadowice. Visit the home where John Paul II was born in 1920 & the church where he was baptized, **Church of Our Lady of Sacrifice**. Visit also **Our Lady of Kalwaria**, favourite praying spot of Pope John Paul II. We continue then to Budapest where we check-in, have dinner and rest for the night. (B/D)

D7: SEP 15 (TUE) BUDAPEST (Hungary)

After breakfast in hotel, shuttle transfer to the IEC Convention Venue. 11:30am – attend **Eucharistic Celebration (Main Presider: Archbishop Jose Palma)** Return shuttle transfer to hotel. (B)

D8: SEP 16 (WED) BUDAPEST - BRATISLAVA (Slovakia)

After breakfast, check-out and proceed on a scenic tour of Bratislava, the capital of Slovakia. Visit the massive courtyard of **Bratislava Castle** for some interesting views. The majestic impression is enhanced by the hill it stands on, some eighty-five meters above the water level of the Danube river. The lovely Rococo palace was the seat of the Governor, Prince Albert, who acquired the office after he married Archduchess Maria Christina, daughter of Queen Maria Theresa. Proceed to dinner before check-in and overnight. (B,D)

D9: SEP 17 (THU) BRATISLAVA - VIENNA - BRATISLAVA (Slovakia)

We explore Vienna today through a guided sightseeing tour. As we drive around the famous ‘Ringstrasse’, Vienna’s main boulevard, we pass by the State Opera, the Museum of Fine Art & National History, the Parliament Building, the Burgtheatre (National Theatre), the City Hall & the University. We visit **Schoenbrunn Palace**, the former summer residence of the Habsburg monarch & is one of the most important cultural monuments in the country. Visit St. **Stephen’s Cathedral**, Austria’s most eminent Gothic edifice, which houses a wealth of art treasures. It is also the Main Church of the Archdiocese of Vienna. Dinner at restaurant then return to hotel. (B/D)

D10: SEP 18 (FRI) BRATISLAVA-BUDAPEST (Hungary)

Check-out and head back to Budapest and indulge in a sightseeing tour of Budapest which features the **Castle Hill, the Fisherman’s Bastion** to enjoy a Panoramic View of the City and the **Parliament House**, the 13th Century **Matthias Coronation Church**, the **Citadel of Mount Gellert** and the **Heroes Square**. (B/D)

D11: SEP 19 (SAT) BUDAPEST (Hungary)

After breakfast in hotel, we enjoy the city’s sights by cruising along the **River Danube**. Glide past landmark monuments such as Buda Castle and the Vigado Concert Hall. Enjoy some leisurely time before heading back to the IEC Venue for the **Holy Eucharist on the Kossuth square** at 5pm followed by a **Eucharistic Candlelight Procession**. Return to hotel for overnight. (B)

D12: SEP 20 (SUN) BUDAPEST (Hungary)

After breakfast, you will be proceed to IEC Venue for the **Statio Orbis - Holy Eucharist on the Heroes’ Square** at 11am. In the afternoon, enjoy a day free at leisure for optional activities or to rest. (B)

D13: SEP 21 (MON) BUDAPEST - VIENNA (Austria)

Check-out of hotel today and transfer to Vienna for an overnight. For some last minute shopping or leisure time, you may drop by the Pandorf Shopping Outlets for some good retail discount shopping. Proceed to hotel for overnight. (B/D)

D14: SEP 22 (TUE) VIENNA - CEBU

Check-out after breakfast and transfer to airport for your flight back to Cebu via Taipei. (B)

D15: SEP 23 (WED) ARRIVE CEBU

Arrival in CEBU.
