DAY 1. MAY 17 CEB/MNL/SAPORRO

DAY 2, MAY 18 ARRIVAL SAPPORO (L/D)

Ohayo Hokkaido! After clearing immigrations, meet your tour guide for a day of exciting sightseeing.

- **Noboribetsu Date Jidaimura** – A theme park with a collection of Edo-styled buildings, reminiscent of the Shogunate, Ninjas and Geishas of the Edo period.
- **Lunch at local restaurant.**
- **Noboribetsu Hell Valley** – Named such because the otherworldliness of the bleached rocks, steaming pools and sulfuric odor, make the scenery so demonic so the area has embraced an ogre theme.
- **Lake Toya** – the scenic volcanic caldera lake is part of the Shikotsu Toya National park, which once hosted the historic G8 Summit in 2008.
- Check in to your ONSEN hotel for dinner and enjoy the hot spring and ONSEN facilities.

DAY 3, MAY 19 SAPPORO – OTARU (B/L/D)

Breakfast in Hotel, then off to a whole day tour:

- **Ice Cream making at Lake Hill Farm** –spectacular views of Lake Toya and Mount Yotei while eating the special gelato you made from fresh cows milk sourced in the farm.
- **Nikka Whiskey Factory** – Japan's top whisky distillery, founded by Taketsuru Masataka, who learned the craft personally in Scotland.
- **Mishima San Pink Moss** (If Weather conditions in Hokkaido are favorable to the blooms).
- **Lunch at local restaurant.**
- **Otaru Canal** – lined with warehouses transformed into museums, curio shops, restaurants, coffee shops
- **Shopping at Sakaimachi Street before dinner at a local restaurant.**
- Check in to Hotel in Otaru.

DAY 4, MAY 20 OTARU – SAPPORO (B/L/D)

After breakfast, check out of your Otaru hotel and travel Sapporo for a day of sightseeing and more shopping!

- **Hokkaido Shrine** – The biggest Shinto Shrine in the area
- **Shiroyo Koibito Park** –famous theme park features a chocolate factory, shops and museums.
- **Lunch in the Park**
- **Odori Park - Sapporo TV Power – Clock Tower** – site of the famed Sapporo Snow Festival in February. At the eastern end of the Park, is the Sapporo TV Tower, with an observation deck that allows you a scenic view of the city of Sapporo.
- **Shopping at Tanuki ko-ji Street** – retail therapy at its best in Sapporo, here you will find the MEGA Don Quixote tax free.
- Dinner at a nearby local restaurant, then return to your Sapporo hotel.

Day 5, MAY 21 SAPPORO DAY TOUR (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel then head on out for the day:

- **Takino Suzuran National Park** – flower gardens, hiking trails, waterfalls and playground equipment. If we are lucky, the tulip gardens may be in full bloom.
- **Sapporo Beer Factory** – A trip to Sapporo is not complete without a visit to the historic beer factory.
- **Lunch at the Sapporo Beer Factory.**
- **Shopping at Mitsui Outlet Mall** – knock yourself out with some serious retail exercise with over 166 shops!
- **Dinner at a local restaurant.**

Day 6, MAY 22 SAPPORO – CEBU (B)

Early departure from hotel to airport for departure back To Cebu (via Manila).
